INSURANCE DEPARTMENT TO HOST CLAIMS VILLAGE IN CHATHAM COUNTY

Atlanta – The Georgia Department of Insurance will host a Catastrophe Claims Village in Chatham County on Wednesday, Sept. 20, and Thursday, Sept. 21. The purpose of the event will be to assist area residents with their insurance questions and claims resulting from Hurricane Irma.

“Chatham County residents have suffered tremendous losses, and we are here to help them on the road to recovery,” Insurance Commissioner Ralph Hudgens said. I encourage all residents who have insurance questions or need help filing a claim to visit our Claims Village.”

The Catastrophe Claims Village will operate in the parking lot of the Home Depot, located at 11180 Abercorn Drive in Savannah, Georgia. Hudgens’ Consumer Services staff and representatives from many of the major insurance companies are scheduled to be in attendance.
