## **HUDGENS: PULASKI COUNTY HOUSE FIRE RULE UNDETERMINED**

**Atlanta** –Investigators with Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner Ralph Hudgens office have ruled a fire that destroyed the home of Superior Court Judge Sarah Wall in Pulaski County undetermined.

The fire, which occurred today around 10 a.m., at 657 Highway 23 West in Hawkinsville, caused an estimated loss of \$300,000. No injuries were reported.

“There was extensive damage caused by this fire, and we cannot eliminate an electrical or mechanical malfunction as the cause,” Commissioner Hudgens said. “However, my investigator found nothing that indicates any deliberate intent was the cause either.”

Hudgens’ office was assisted in the investigation by the Hawkinsville/Pulaski County Fire Department. The fire appears to have started in a stable adjacent to the home.
